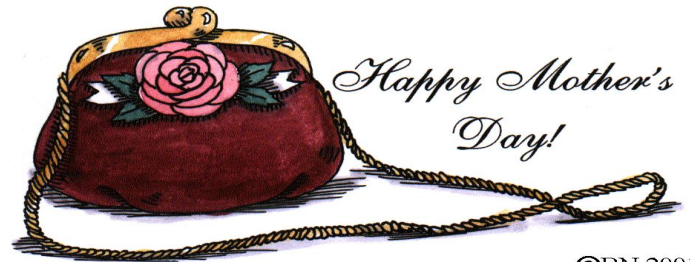

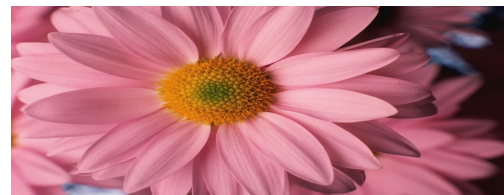

## Boy Scout Leader Training

The Diocese of Harrisburg Catholic Committee on Scouting (DCCS) will be holding its Leader Training on Saturday, May 19, 2012 at 1:15 PM at the Cardinal Keeler Center in Harrisburg. The training is available for all Scout Leaders in Catholic chartered units and Catholic Leaders in non-Catholic units. Adult Scouters can attend Train the Trainer, Scouter Development or the Boy Scout Religious Emblem training held for Ad Altare Dei (AAD) Counselors and Pope Pius XII Emblem Moderators. Train the Trainer is for past AAD Counselors and PPXII Moderators who want to train other Scouters, Scouter Development is an Adult Leader Emblem, while Ad Altare Dei and Pope Pius XII are Emblems for the scouts. However, adults have to be trained to lead the two scout emblems. Religious Emblem Counselors and Moderators should take retraining every 2 to 3 years to keep updated. These trainings are held twice a year, once in the Fall at the Annual Boy Scout Retreat and once in the late spring at the Diocesan Center. 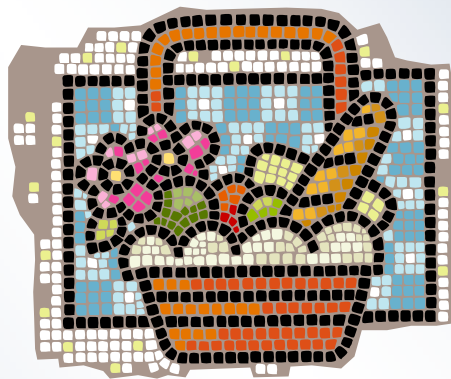
